Grants: Funds raised each year are awarded via a grants application, review and evaluation process.

Administrative and General: Volunteer opportunities include:

- Secretary, Treasurer, Legal Advisor and others. Skills and roles that are helpful to this area are Word Processing, Excel Spreadsheet, Accountants/CPAs, Lawyers as well as good communication skills.
